

Dua:

FOR ADULT MAN OR WOMAN

Allaahumm-aghfir li hayyinaa wa mayyitinaa, wa shaahidinaa wa ghaa'ibinaa, wa sagheerinaa wa kabeerinaa, wa dhakarinaa wa unthaanaa, Allaahumma man ahyaytahu minnaa fa-ahyihi 'alaal-islam, wa man tawaffaytahu minnaa fa tawaffahu 'alaal-'eemaan,

O Allah, Forgive, our living and our dead, those present and those absent, our young and our old, our males and our females.

O Allah, Whom amongst us You keep alive, then let such a life be upon Islam, and whom amongst us You take unto Yourself, then let such a death be upon faith.

Say Allahu Akbar and conclude with Salaam.

FOR A CHILD

Allahummaj alhu (boy) / alha (girl) lana faratan waj alhu(boy) / alha (girl) lana ajran wa zukhran waj alhu (boy) / (girl) alha lana 'shafi an' (boy) / 'shafi atan' (girl) wa 'mushaffa an' (boy) / 'mushaffatan' (girl).

O Allah, make him/her (this child) for our means of preservation and make him/her a source of reward and treasure for us and make him/her a pleader for us and one whose pleading is accepted.

AT THE GRAVEYARD

Dua for lowering the body

Bismillaahi wa 'alaa sunnati Rasoolillaahi or
In the name of Allah, (we bury) according to the sunnah of the Prophet of Allah

Bismillaahi wa 'alaa millati Rasoolillaahi
In the name of Allah, (we bury) according to the way of the Prophet of Allah

To be recited when placing soil in the grave.

MINHA KHLAQNAKUM

From the Earth did WE make you

WA FIHA NU IDUKUM

And into you shall return

WA MINHA NUKHRIJUKUM TARATAN UKHRA

And from it Shall WE bring you out once again

REGISTERING THE DEATH

Obtain Death Certificate from Doctor
Make an appointment at local registrars to
Register Death.

Details Required to Register Death

- Full details of Deceased and spouse
- Names and Occupations of the Parents of deceased
- Name and Address of GP for the Deceased
- Passport/ Birth/ Marriage Certificate (if available)
- In the event of a Medical Review – request fast track service under religious grounds.

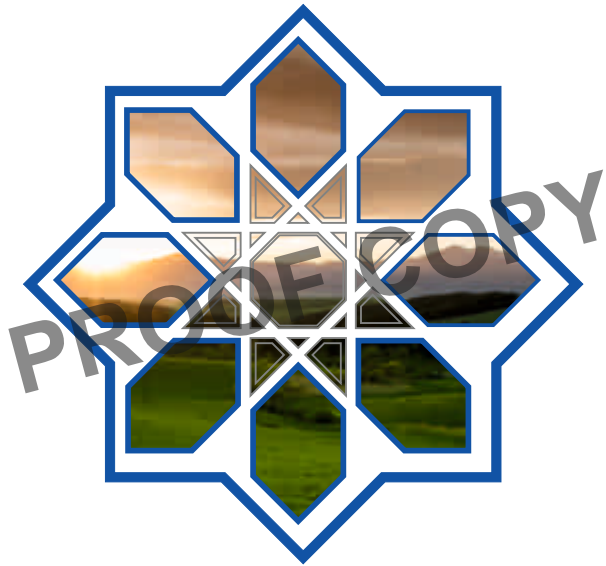

WHEN DEATH OCCURS

- Remove any jewellery
- Close the eyes
- Ask nurse to remove all needles and tubing
- Close mouth and bandage from under chin to over the crown of the head
- Tilt head to right
- Lay the body flat
- Straighten fingers, arms and legs
- Tie large toes together with a bandage or similar
- Contact Funeral Services

When the soul has left the body

Allahuma a'inee alaa ghamaraatil mawti wa sakaratil mawti

Translation

O Allah, At this time of severity of death help me

Dua for closing the eyes of the dead

Allahumm-aghfir li [mention the person's name] warfa' darajatahu/ darajatahaa (female) fil-mahdiyyiyna, wakhluflu/ wakhluflhaa (female) fee 'aqibihi fil-ghaabireena, waghfir lanaa/ lahaa (female) wa lahu/ lahaa (female) yaa rabbal-'aalameena, wafsaḥ lahu/ lahaa (female) fee qabrihi wa nawwir lahu/ lahaa(female) feeh

Translation

O Allah, forgive – [person's name] - and raise his/her rank among the rightly guided, and be a successor to whom he/she has left behind, and forgive us and him/her O Lord of the worlds. Make spacious his/her grave and illuminate it for him/her.

Salatul Janazah (The Funeral Prayer)

Salatul Janazah is Fard Kafayah, that is, if one prays the prayer then all are bareeuz zimma (free of the responsibility) otherwise all those who received the news but did not come are sinners. Jamaat is not a condition for this prayer it is sufficient even if one person prays, and to deny the fardiat (compulsion) of this is salah is kufr (an act of disbelief). As with the normal 5 times daily salah, wudu must be done for this salah.

There are two parts of this salah

- 1) 4 takbeer, to say Allahu Akbar four times
- 2) Qayam which is 3 sunnah muakeda: Thana, Durood Shareef and Duaa for the deceased.

How to pray

Intention:

Muqtadee (those standing for the salatul janazah) should make intention (niyyat). "I make the niyyat for the prayer of this janazah for Allah, dua for this deceased behind this imam" Now the Imam and muqtadee should raise their hands to their ears and fold their hands underneath the naval as usual whilst saying Allahu Akbar and read the thana

Thana:

Subhanak-Allahumma wa bi-hamdika wa tabarak-asmuka wa ta'ala jadduka wa jalla thana'uku wa la-ilaha ghairuk. Glory be to Thee, O Allah, and I praise Thee. Blessed is Thy name and Thou art exalted. Thy praise is glorified, and there is no god other than Thee. Say Allahu Akbar and recite Durood Ibrahim

Durood Ibrahim:

Allahumma sall-i 'ala Muhammad-in wa 'ala al-i Muhammad-in kama sallaita wa sallamta wa barakta wa rahimta wa tarahhamta 'ala Ibrahima wa 'ala al-i Ibrahima Innaka Hamidum-Majid

O Allah, Have Mercy on Muhammad and on those related to Muhammad, just as Thou hast mercy and Thou sendeth peace and blessings and hath Compassion on Abraham and on those related to Abraham. Surely, Thou art Praiseworthy, the Great!"

If this cannot be memorised with ease, then the durood Ibrahim which is read during salah can be read.

Say Allahu Akbar and pray for the deceased
